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REPORTING SCHEDULE

Summary Environmental Report Descriptions Federal and State of Ohio

• Semi-Annual Ohio Title V Deviation Report

Applies to facilities which are major sources of air emissions and which have a Title V Permit. This report documents any deviations from regulatory and permit requirements, for the preceding 6-month period.

• SARA Title III, Tier I/Tier II Report

Applies to facilities that store hazardous chemicals in quantities of 10,000 pounds or more. Extremely Hazardous Substance have reporting thresholds of 500 pounds or the threshold planning quantity, whichever is lower.

• Annual Hazardous Waste

Applies only to Large Quantity Generators of hazardous waste.

• SARA Title III, Tier I/Tier II Fee

Applies to facilities that store hazardous chemicals in quantities of 10,000 pounds or more. Extremely Hazardous Substance have reporting thresholds of 500 pounds or the threshold planning quantity, whichever is lower.

• Synthetic Minor Title V Emission Fee Report

Applies to facilities that have been issued a Federally Enforceable State of Operation Permit (FESOP) or synthetic minor PTI in order to opt out of the Title V permitting requirements.

• Title V Fee Emissions Report & Emissions Inventory Summary

Applies to facilities which are major sources of air emissions and which have a Title V Permit. Each Title V facility needs to submit a fee emission report annually to the Ohio EPA.

• Non-Title V Emission Fee Report

Applies to facilities with air permits within Ohio that are not subject to Title V.

• Ohio Title V Certification

Applies to facilities which are major sources of air emissions and which have a Title V Permit. This report is signed by the facility's Responsible Official and provides a certified statement of compliance.
